

What is blended learning?

Blended learning (also known as hybrid learning) provides a combination of in-person instruction with dynamic digital activities and content. In a blended-learning model, the teacher facilitates student learning, providing them with digital media, online resources and tools, as well as support and guidance.

Blended Learning Models

Model 1

- learners rotate between learning modalities on a fixed schedule (i.e. they take turns)

Rotation

Model 2

- learners follow a personalised schedule online that includes some teacher support.

Flex

Model 3

- learners get to choose what and when they learn. Their outcomes are the same, but not the content.

Choice

Model 4

- learners are provided with most content online with occasional classroom attendance.
