Quick Guide Differentiation



What is differentiation?

Differentiation is instruction that is tailored to the specific needs (readiness, interests and learning level) of each student. The teacher varies the content, process and environment to help ensure that students with different needs and abilities are each being challenged and individually supported.

To meet the learning needs of each student, teachers can vary the activity types and teaching strategies that each student receives, as well as increase or decrease the level of challenge.
