Do you like drawing animals? Some people find it easy to draw animals.				
Other people find it tricky!				
If you follow these steps you can draw a cute cat.				
Look carefully at the picture for each step. The pictures will help you draw your cat.				
<b>You will need:</b> plain paper lead pencil Eraser black marker coloured pencils				

<b>What to do:</b>				
<b>Step 1</b> Draw an oval in the top half of the page. This will be the head.				
<b>Step 2</b> Draw a small triangle inside the oval. This will be the nose.				
<b>Step 3</b> Draw two small triangles on the top of the oval. These will be the ears.				
<b>Step 4</b> Draw a smaller triangle inside each ear.				
<b>Step 5</b> Draw two circles above the nose. Put dots inside. These will be the eyes.				
<b>Step 6</b> Draw two curved lines under the nose. These lines make the mouth.				
<b>Step 7</b> Draw three straight lines on each side of the head. These are the whiskers.				
<b>Step 8</b> Draw a bigger oval under the head. This will be the body of the cat.				

<p><b>Step 9</b></p> <p>Draw two long sausage shapes on the body. These are the front legs.</p>				
<p><b>Step 10</b></p> <p>Draw two little sausage shapes on the body. These are the back legs.</p>				
<p><b>Step 11</b></p> <p>Draw a long curvy tail.</p>				
<p><b>Step 10</b></p> <p>Trace your cat in marker. Rub out any lead pencil you can still see.</p>				
<p><b>Step 12</b></p> <p>Colour and decorate your cat any way you like!</p>				
<p><b>TIP</b></p> <p>If you make a mistake at any step you can erase the mistake and start that step again.</p>
