What is Learn and Practice?

Learning that is most effective includes carefully sequenced steps that provide students with opportunities to practice along the way. Well-designed lessons that scaffold understanding are followed by intervals that enable the student to put in place what they have learned.

Programs that get students the best results include:



Explicit Instruction

- clear and detailed instructions that are carefully planned and sequenced.



Real-World Examples

- examples that help illustrate the information in the instruction.



Plenty of Practice

- opportunities to put in place what has been modelled or demonstrated.



Timely Assessment

- a tool to measure student knowledge and understanding.
