The Literacy Check is a simple literacy test that is mapped to LiteracyPlanet's Literacy Continuum. It is only short, consisting of 4 - 15 concepts per strand and only takes between 15 - 30 minutes to complete, depending on individual student ability. The check helps educators see how their students are working within each strand of literacy.

How will the Literacy Check help educators?

The Literacy Check provides educators with a snapshot overview of how their students are working within each strand of literacy at a specific learning level. The Literacy Check signifies whether students should be moving up or down a learning level across each strand of literacy, or whether they should continue at their current learning level.

How does the Literacy Check work?

Once the student is assigned a Literacy Check, they will complete a set of questions before proceeding with their learning journey or engaging in other activities. The Literacy Check can be assigned at any time during the student's learning journey.

As students complete the Literacy Check, the report is updated in real-time, giving you instant visibility of individual student proficiency.
