

## What is progress monitoring?

Individual and whole class/group reports enable teachers to quickly identify how students are working, whether they require intervention or extension, as well as what topic areas require special attention in their classroom. Teachers use these reports to monitor the progress of their students in a specific learning area, such as literacy or numeracy.

Progress reports provide teachers with detailed breakdowns of how each student is progressing in the classroom. With the information provided by the reports, teachers can determine whether to provide extra support or extension, and whether the interventions have been successful.
